Your costs of production are normally about 40% of wholesale price which is then multiplied by 2,5-2,7 to get the retail price. For example, if a dress cost you $\text{£}20$ to make you'll sell it at $\text{£}50$ to wholesalers, and they will sell it in their shop at $\text{£}125$ - $\text{£}135$
